

Constructing Major Scales


Write out the musical alphabet several times:

Circle of Fifths/Fourths



Order of Flats - B E A D G C F

Order of Sharps - F C G D A E B

Remember, when using the order of sharps and order of flats, ALWAYS count from the beginning.
