## accidentals

An accidental in is a symbol placed before a music note, which alters the pitch of that note by raising or lowering it from its original pitch.

The three symbols are a sharp  $(\sharp)$ , flat  $(\flat)$ , and a natural  $(\flat)$ .

A <b>sharp</b> raises the pitch by one half step. Draw five sharps here: #	
A <b>flat</b> lowers the pitch by one half step. Draw five flats here:	
A <b>natural</b> cancels a sharp or flat. Draw five naturals here:	<u> </u>
